A nonreassuring count should prompt notification for further fetal assessment. The non-stress test (NST) and the ultrasound biophysical profile (BPP) are the primary antenatal fetal surveillance methods now used. The NST is based on the principle that the fetal heart will accelerate with movement in a fetus with normal autonomic function.

NST/AFI: Weekly starting at 36 weeks; Asthma (Symptomatic) NST/AFI: Weekly starting at 34 weeks; Third Trimester abdominal surgery (e.g. Appendectomy) NST/AFI: Weekly starting at date of surgery; Post-term (>41 weeks) NST/AFI: Bi-weekly starting at 41 weeks; Previous fetal demise or Stillbirth. NST/AFI: Weekly starting at time of IUFD or 32 weeks

A fetal monitor is used, so two small monitor parts will be fastened around your abdomen with soft belts. Invasive Prenatal Testing involves the insertion of a probe or needle either through the abdominal wall (transabdominal) or the cervix (transcervical) for an examination of the fetus. The procedures are mostly painless and performed under local anaesthesia.
