The success of the field is marked by a graduate program at York University, archives, and scholarly societies.

History of Psychology Goes International

While psychology did not emerge as a separate discipline until the late 1800s, its earliest history can be traced back to the time of the early Greeks. During the 17th-century, the French philosopher Rene Descartes introduced the idea of dualism, which asserted that the mind and body were two entities that interact to form the human experience.

The Origins of Psychology: History Through the Years

The schools of psychology that we will review are summarized in Table 1.3, "The Most Important Approaches (Schools) of Psychology," while Table 1.4, "History of Psychology," presents a timeline of some of the most important psychologists, beginning with the early Greek philosophers and extending to the present day.

1.2 The Evolution of Psychology: History, Approaches, and ...

Psychology was a branch of the domain of philosophy until the 1870s, when it developed as an independent scientific discipline in Germany. Psychology as a self-conscious field of experimental study began in 1879, in Leipzig Germany, when Wilhelm Wundt founded the first laboratory dedicated exclusively to psychological research in Germany.

The modern discipline of psychology began in the 19th century. In the premodern Islamic context, the term "psychology" referred to the study of human mind and behavior, while the term "mind" referred to human intellect and consciousness. Thus, medieval Islamic psychology did not deal with the mind only (Ashy, 1999).
