The ‘Scud C’ is believed to be an improved version of the SS-1C ‘Scud B’. It is 11.25 m in length, 0.88 m in diameter, and has a launch weight of 6,400 kg. The missile has a range of 550 km with a payload of 600 kg. This payload is capable of holding a single separating high explosive warhead with an accuracy of 700 m CEP.
